**Code of Conduct
for Mediators, Adjudicators, Arbitrators,**

By accepting appointment as a either an Adjudicator or Arbitrator, the Adjudicator / Arbitrator agrees to strictly adhere to IICArb's Code of Conduct, as set out hereunder:-

1. By accepting appointment as Adjudicator or Arbitrator, the Adjudicator/Arbitrator shall ensure that he/she is not in conflict of interest and shall disclose same to the parties and IICArb.
2. The Adjudicator/Arbitrator warrants that he/she is competent to adjudicate the dispute between the parties.
3. The Adjudicator/Arbitrator shall ensure that he/she is available to adjudicate the dispute and shall put all reasonable effort to ensure that the dispute is resolved as soon as reasonably possible.
4. The Adjudicator/Arbitrator shall remain impartial and independent at all times during the dispute resolution proceedings up to publication of the decision/award.
5. The proceedings shall be treated strictly confidential and be held in private unless otherwise agreed between the parties.
6. The Adjudicator/Arbitrator must discharge with integrity his/her duties to ensure fair administration and justice between the parties.
7. The Adjudicator/Arbitrator undertakes to fully cooperate with IICArb as regards the administration of the dispute resolution proceedings.
8. The Adjudicator/Arbitrator shall abide by IICArb's relevant rules and any other rules published by its IICArb from time to time.
9. The Adjudicator/Arbitrator shall ensure punctuality.
10. The Adjudicator/Arbitrator shall advise the parties how they are to address and refer to the Adjudicator/Arbitrator.
11. The Adjudicator/Arbitrator shall ensure that he/she remains professional throughout the dispute resolution proceedings.
12. The Adjudicator/Arbitrator shall ensure that any communications made to one party shall include the other party.
