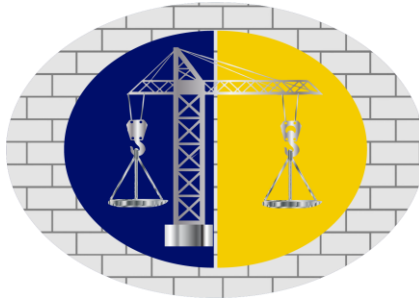
PANEL REGISTRATION CRITERIA

MEDIATORS

- Work experience in the construction industry for a period of at least 5 years
- Attended a training course in mediation – approved by IICArb unless the applicant was previously appointed as an mediator in respect of at least 3 matters
- Must be able to show thorough understanding of the mediation process and procedure, and the mediator’s role
- Proficient in English speaking and writing
- Must have experience in at least one industry standard form contract
- Satisfactory standing in his/her profession or occupation
- Basic understanding of the different forms of ADR
- Involvement in at least 3 matters referred to mediation in the last 2 years

ADJUDICATORS

- Work experience in the construction industry for a period of at least 7 years
- Attended a training course in adjudication – approved by IICArb unless the applicant was previously appointed as an adjudicator in respect of at least 3 matters
- Must be able to show thorough understanding of the adjudication process and procedure, and adjudicator’s powers and function
- Proficient in English speaking and writing
- Must have experience in at least one industry standard form contract
- Satisfactory standing in his/her profession or occupation
- Basic understanding of the different forms of ADR
- Involvement in at least 3 cases referred to adjudication in the last 2 years

ARBITRATORS

- Work experience in the construction industry for a period of at least 10 years
 - Attended a training course in arbitration – approved by IICArb unless the applicant was previously appointed as an arbitrator in respect of at least 3 matters
 - Must be able to show thorough understanding of the arbitration process and procedure, and arbitrator’s powers and function
 - Proficient in English speaking and writing
 - Must have experience in at least one industry standard form contract
 - Satisfactory standing in his/her profession or occupation
 - Basic understanding of the different forms of ADR
 - Involvement in at least 3 cases referred to arbitration in the last 3 years
 - Understanding construction law and arbitration law

- Panel members will be required to maintain continuous professional development and must submit proof of training of least 2 CPD points on an annual basis.
 - IICArb may require successful applicant to write a short assessment in verification of the above criteria.
 - Should the applicant not meet the aforesaid criteria, his/her application will not necessarily automatically be rejected. IICArb may accept the application subject to certain conditions that may require the applicant to attend such further training etc as IICArb determines necessary to develop the applicant for the position of panel membership applied for.
